

Minutes City Council Meeting
September 20, 2005

This meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Englund. Aldermen David Peterson, Ron Cox and Dick Hulslander were present. Earl Starks was absent with no notice. Donna Clarke was absent with prior notice.

The only item on the agenda was the health insurance.

David Peterson made a motion to choose TML, \$750 with the \$25 Office Visit Co-Pay. The premiums will be \$498.71 EE and \$629.43 Composite dependent. The dependent payroll deduction is capped at \$500. At the end of the fiscal year, \$250 of the \$750 deductible will be reimbursed to the employee upon request and proof of expense via an EOB statement showing that the employee has met the \$750 deductible. This reimbursement is capped at \$250, but can apply to employee or dependent expense. This action is taken as an added benefit, and the reimbursement is not meant to be considered as a pay rate increase.

The annual city expense under this plan based on a staff of nine is \$56,890.

Ron Cox seconded this proposal.

All councilmen voted aye and the measure was adopted.

Under open forum the council discussed the roof repair to city hall. The building has not been repaired yet. It needs foundation ventilation and it needs a levy built on the north side. This action will be taken up at the October council meeting. The council said to not do the roof repair until the building is fixed.
